Take action and help reduce the dangerous effects of heat!

Organized by the Christa McAuliffe Center at Framingham State University in collaboration with NOAA and CAPA to collect data in **Framingham, Natick, Ashland, and Holliston.**

WHO: You! Volunteers will be asked to drive their cars or navigate during the data collection process. You will receive necessary equipment, detailed information, and training.

WHAT: Drive or navigate a route in high heat areas to collect temperature and humidity. Your contribution will reveal the distribution of heat across our region, helping local cities and towns to plan future relief strategies.

WHEN: Target campaign date is around July 13th. You can choose to volunteer for any one of three shifts: Morning, Afternoon, or Evening.
*date is subject to change based on weather conditions.
