- Due to the closing of Woodland St, there is no parking on Elm St from Woodland St to Grove St. This is causing a lot of the traffic to the schools to use Grove St as a cut through. In addition, the lack of parking on Elm St now is causing people to park on Grove St. The amount of parking on Grove Street has doubled and it is causing the following issues for those residents:
 - No Parking on both sides of Grove St between Hampshire and Church St
 - Delivery trucks can't get access to parking lot to Daniels House
 - Residents can't get out of driveways
 - Trash pickup affected - the drivers need to get out of truck and physically

Petitioner is requesting to restrict parking on both sides of Grove St between Hampshire and Church St
