**DISCUSSION ITEMS:** 

- 1) Jeff Ritter asked for clarification on the schedule. Approximate dates are as follows:
  - a) Jeff has drafted a RFP which is under legal review. Jay noted that Gill expects to submit at the beginning of August.
  - b) 7/31/2017 8Arch will request Final deliverable from Gill
    - i) ACTION -Request deliverable from Gill by July 31st.
  - c) 8/1/2017 8Arch will review Gill's submittal
  - d) 8Arch return design review comments to Gill.
  - e) 8/7/2017 8Arch present project update to BoS.
  - f) 8/8/2017 Final review of Gill's documents
  - g) 8/16/2017 Advertise (Central Register, Milford Daily News)
  - h) 9/8/2017 Pre-Bid walk through approx. 2 weeks before the bid.
  - i) 9/15/2017 Questions due approx. 1 week before the bid.
  - j) 9/22/2017 Response Date Bid Opening.
  - k) Review of bids by Town and Gill.
  - 1) Award
  - m) Construction Phase begins. Dennis anticipates that precast lead time will be approximately 16 weeks.
  - n) Construction complete by the end of May 2018.

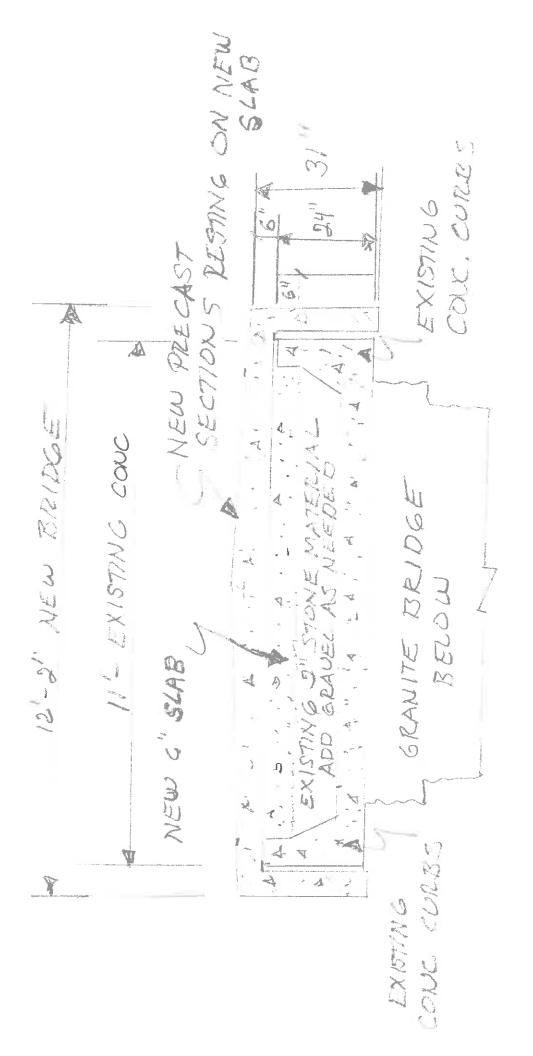
- 2) Additional Discussion Re: Construction Phase
  - a) Staging Areas It is anticipated that the Contractor will use the rail trail alignment.
    - i) There is Town land behind Holliston Oil / VFW, in addition to the rail trail itself.
    - ii) ACTION -Robert will prepare a plan to clarify potential staging areas. Locus map will include area to store the gravel removed from the existing bridge, to be reused on the trail.
  - b) Expect a question from Bidders regarding what the allowance is for police details.
  - c) ACTION Jay will provide Order of Conditions to the Town and to Gill.
- 3) Discussion of Robert's exposed concern about a variable finish at coping façade at the closure pour locations.
  - a) ACTION Dennis will follow up with Gill next week. He believes the closure pour will be inside the coping.
- 4) Railing Geometry
  - a) Committee discussed a variety of railing designs. Committee concurs that the railing should have a top rub rail, a toe rail, diagonal cross-bracing and square wire mesh. Max wire mesh spacing per AASHTO is 2" x 2". Anticipated post spacing is 8 -10 feet, as best to coordinate with the precast panel lengths, as determined by Gill. Precast downturn height to be defined relative to the top course of the granite from an aesthetic standpoint.
  - b) ACTION -8Arch Committee to follow-up with Gill on desired railing.
- 5) Herb Brockert Alternate Concept (attached)
  - a) After discussion, committee agreed not to pursue the alternate concept.
  - b) VOTE Dennis made a motion to withdraw the alternate concept from further consideration. Paul seconded. All in favor.
  - c) Ken noted his support of removing the existing coping in order to minimize problems / maintenance / costs in the future. Saving construction cost on this item could translate into increased future costs, which should be avoided.
- 6) Approval of Meeting Minutes from Prior Meetings
  - a) July 11, 2017
    - i) VOTE: Alison made a Motion to Approve the meeting minutes. Paul seconded. All in favor.
  - b) Alison will send finalized meeting minutes to Town.
- 7) Meeting adjourned.
