To the extent that the ideas require funding, the committee should identify relevant funding sources.

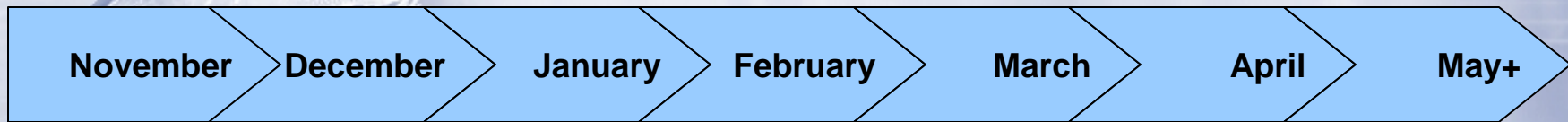
