

ELDERLY & DISABLED TAX RELIEF COMMITTEE

TUESDAY, MARCH 23, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 a.m. in the Selectmen's Meeting Room, Town Hall.

Mary Bousquet advised that Committee that we had a total of five applicants, four of which were paid in full through hardship exemptions and CPA abatements through the Board of Assessors, and one still had a small balance remaining.

The Committee voted unanimously to deny the following applicants tax relief because their 2010 real estate taxes have been paid in full.

59 Maple Dell Lane
66 Shaw Farm Road
31 Stony Brook Drive
123 Goulding Street

The applicant at 13 Jarr Brook Road is a taxpayer who is 54 years old and disabled. The Town currently has a tax lien on the property upon which the taxpayer pays \$100 per month out of her monthly income of \$844. The applicant received a hardship exemption in the amount of \$3000 and a CPA abatement in the amount of \$41.71. The balance due on the 2010 tax bill is \$1,523.93.

The motion was made by Mary Bousquet that the Committee grant relief in the amount of \$1,523.93 to pay the 2010 taxes in full. The motion was seconded by Peter Barbieri. The Committee voted unanimously to approve the applicant at 13 Jarr Brook Road tax relief in the amount of \$1,523.93.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:20 a.m.
