

### DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. **Approval of April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 Meeting Notes.** Matt Varrell moved to approve the April meeting notes, Nik Parrish seconded; the vote was 4-0-0 for approval.
2. **New Trails Committee Member Introduction.** Robert Weidknecht introduced the newest committee member, Melissa Halstead to the group. She will participate as a non-voting member until she is able to be sworn in.
3. **Invoice for Town Counsel Services.** An invoice for services rendered in the amount of \$145.00 from the town counsel was presented to the committee for review and payment approval. Matt Varrell moved to accept for payment from the DCR Grant; Nik Parrish seconded; the vote for approval was 4-0-0.
4. **Election of the Position of Committee Chair and Secretary.** Matt Varrell moved to accept the nomination of Robert Weidknecht for the Committee Chairman position and Matt Varrell as the Committee Secretary. Nik Parrish seconded the motion. Both nominees agreed to service in those respective capacities, and the vote to accept them was 4-0-0.

5. **Signature Authorities – Primary and Alternate.** Robert Weidknecht and Matt Varrell agreed to serve as primary and alternate signature representative for the committee. Matt Varrell moved that they be accepted as such; Nik Parrish seconded; the vote was 4-0-0.
6. **Adams School Student Clean-up Day.** Nik Parrish has agreed to again coordinate the planned student annual cleanup activities scheduled for June 3<sup>rd</sup>. The section of the trail that the students will concentrate on will be from Hopping Brook Road to South Street. They will rake leaf and twig debris from the trail prior to the effort to grade it smooth.
7. **ALIM Parcel Disposition.** Robert Weidknecht mentioned that the ALIM organization has agreed to donate their portion of the rail trail to the town. Robert will continue to work with them to that end.
8. **HTC Trail Clean-Up Day.** The Trails Committee agreed to hold a clean-up effort on the section of the trail between the Mayflower Landing and the Sherborn town line on June 12<sup>th</sup> at 9:00am. The participants will meet at Brook Street near the town well in that area. An alternate rain date of Sunday the 13<sup>th</sup> at 1:00pm will be used if necessary.
9. **June Trails Committee Meeting.** The next meeting has been scheduled for June 16<sup>th</sup> (Wednesday) at 7:00pm in the Holliston Town Hall.
10. **Meeting Adjournment.** Nik Parrish motioned to adjourn the meeting; Marc Connelly seconded; the vote was 4-0-0 in favor. The meeting was adjourned at 8:25pm.
