

Lake Winthrop Beach at Stoddard Park & Pleasure Point Beach

Use of Lake Winthrop & Pleasure Point Beach requires a parking sticker. Parking stickers are available at the Recreation Office & Treasurer's Office at the Town Hall. Beach sticker must be affixed on lower corner of drivers' side front windshield. Please note: Parking stickers are required for Stoddard Park and Pleasure Point. Pleasure Point open to residents only.

Beach Hours of Operation

Stoddard Park Beach will be guarded June 22– August 13
 Monday- Friday only.
 9:00 am - 4:00 pm Monday - Friday
 No guards on weekends
 Parking Sticker/Day Pass still required for entry.

Parking Stickers

\$30.00 Resident first car
 \$5.00 Senior Citizen
 \$10.00 Resident second car
 \$60.00 Non-resident (no entry July 4th)

Day Passes:

Resident \$10 .00
 Non-resident \$20.00

Buses or vehicles with 9 or more passengers: \$2.00 per person

*Resident day Passes that are purchased at Stoddard Park and can be credited toward the purchase of a sticker with receipt at the Recreation Office or the Treasurer's Office.

One non-resident day pass may be applied to purchase of beach sticker.

We will not replace lost parking stickers under any circumstance.

Beach Rules

NOTICE: FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH RULES LISTED BELOW WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF WATERFRONT PRIVILEGES.

1. Beach sticker or day pass required. Beach sticker must be affixed on lower corner of driver's front windshield.
2. Swim at own risk when no lifeguard on duty.
3. Children under age 11 must be supervised by an adult.
4. No glass or alcohol allowed.
5. No dogs or pets.
6. Do not feed the geese or ducks.
7. No flips, dives, or back dives off the dock.
8. No snorkels, fins, floatation devices, water wings, life jackets, nets, or large beach balls (larger than a volleyball).
9. Children must be able to swim out to the dock on their own, not carried.
10. No nude bathing.
11. No boats allowed in the swimming area.
12. No smoking.
13. No babies in diapers. Babies must wear leak resistant swim pants.



Parking Sticker Application

Parking stickers will be available at the Treasurer's Office and Recreation Office, OR– you may obtain your sticker by mailing your check, a self-addressed, stamped envelope and this form to: The Holliston Recreation Department, 100 Linden St., Holliston, MA 01746 or to Treasurer's Office, PO BOX 6737, Holliston, MA 01746. You must include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you want the sticker mailed to you.

Fee: \$30 for resident first car
 \$10 for resident second car
 \$5 for Senior Citizen (65 and older)

\$60 for non-resident (no entry July 4th)
\$10 for a resident day pass
\$20 for a non-resident day pass

Resident day passes can be purchased at Stoddard Park and can be credited toward the purchase of a sticker with a receipt at the Recreation Office or Treasurer's Office. One non-resident day passes may be applied to purchase of parking sticker.
