**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

The Board of Water Commissioners for the Town of Holliston, Massachusetts will receive sealed bids for Mixing System and Miscellaneous Repairs, Water Storage Tanks, until 11:00 a.m. Local Time on Tuesday, March 30, 2010, at the Water Department Office, Town Hall, 703 Washington Street, Holliston, Massachusetts 01746, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in the Conference Room.

The work of this project consists of furnishing and installing one complete hydrodynamic mixing system at Hopping Brook tank, and miscellaneous repairs, pressure washing, spot cleaning and painting at Hopping Brook, Beatrice, and Jennings tanks.

THE ESTIMATED COST FOR THIS PROJECT IS APPROXIMATELY \$110,000.

Contract documents will be mailed to prospective bidders upon receipt of a separate check or money order for \$30.00 made payable to AP Associates, Inc., which will not be refunded. Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of five (5) percent of the value of the bid in the form described in the DOCUMENT 00100, INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS.

A performance bond and a payment bond, each in the amount of one hundred (100) percent of the contract price, will be required in the form described in the DOCUMENT 00100, INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS.

Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Deputy Director of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development under the provision of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Sections 26 to 27H, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the Bidder, before Bid opening, to request, if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those trades people who may be employed for the proposed work under this contract.

Bidders attention is called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed, minimum state wage rates to be paid and payroll submission requirements under the contract.

No Bidder may withdraw his Bid within thirty (30) days (Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays excluded) after the actual date of the Bid opening.

Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the DOCUMENT 00100, INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS.

The total time for completion of all work is 80 consecutive calendar days. Work performed beyond the specified time periods will be subject to liquidated damages in the amount specified. It is the intent of this contract for the work to begin immediately after the execution of the contract and for all work to be completed by July 1, 2010, unless the completion time is extended by the Owner. In any case, the tanks shall remain in service between July 1 and September 1, 2010.

This Contract is being bid on under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30, Section 39M.

The Owner may waive any informalities or minor defects, or reject any or all Bids if it is in the best interest of the Owner to do so.
