Trimming the roadways. Invasive plants overtaking some major roads in Holliston. The Highway Dept was contacted and asked to trim. They do trim roadways at least once a year. There have been several meetings over past 5 or 6 years regarding this issue. Individuals and groups attempting to coordinate a collective effort to address. It was suggested that the Ag extension office might be willing to come evaluate Holliston's situation. While this is not an AgCom issue, the AgCom will send an email to farms on Highland Street reminding them they can contact the Highway Department and request they trim whatever is overgrowing the sidewalks and streets.

PJ reported he sent the MA Grown map and application to all farms, but has not received a response from anyone.

Community Garden: PJ update Patching wood on raised beds for the last 2 years: how can the committee gradually replace with more long-term material? 12 15 beds are no longer able to just be patched. There are 40 linear feet for each of the 33 plots: beds are 10 x 10 (approximately 7 cell blocks per side). However, concrete blocks would heave in winter so until there is another economical solution timber will continue to be used.
 - i) Maintenance: need \$1000 to purchase new boards and chicken wire for the perimeter, and to schedule a work party in November.
