#### **Health Director's Report**

- Visiting Nurse update: Natick VNA will stop doing our MAVEN and contagious disease work as of April 1, 2018. Scott will meet with Salmon VNA on 2-21-18 to discuss working with them. There are several other options we are exploring. See attached office notes. We are working diligently to secure a replacement for a seamless transition.
- **Town Hall update:** 90% of the Town Hall clean-up is complete. They are looking at replacing the carpeting, even though carpeting in a basement-below ground level was not recommended by the State Air Quality test report. The State will be back in the spring for a retest.
- **FY'19 Budget:** Scott presented the budget to the Finance Committee on Tuesday per their recommended FinCom guidelines (attached). It has a slight increase for Professional Services and Nursing because of the termination of the Natick VNA contract, but otherwise level funded. The FinCom said they would recommend another 1% salary increase on the Town Meeting floor.
- **157 Lowland:** Scott updated the Board on the submittal to the State by Mike Brumber. The Conservation Commission, Building, Planning & Health Departments are reviewing the submittal for inaccuracies and will be working with Town Council. The Selectmen will need to determine if a hearing is in order.
- **High School therapists** are on sight to provide support in light of the recent Florida school shooting.
- **Flu update:** The State still hasn't released whether the Haverhill child flu fatality had gotten a flu vaccination.
