Request for a Certificate of Compliance - DEP #185-843: #289 Hollis Street

Mr. Clapp reported that this property had just recently hydro-seeded the lawn, and therefore
the grass was not stabilized. Additionally, he expressed concerns about the size of boulders
used as permanent markers, and has requested the applicant either entrench the boulders or
use larger boulders. Otherwise, the site was in compliance and he recommended the issuance
of a Partial Certificate of Compliance.

Ms. Pilch made a motion to issue a Partial Certificate of Compliance for DEP #185-843: #289 Hollis Street. Ms. Buttaro seconded the motion. Vote passes unanimously (5-0-0).

- An abutter notification for a public information meeting about the Marshall Street solar project was circulated. The meeting will be during the Select Board meeting on Monday, August 12th.
- The latest edition of *Erosion Control* magazine was circulated.
- An advertisement for materials and structures from the Department of Corrections was circulated. It was suggested Mr. Clapp forward this to Mr. Mark Frank, Director of Parks and Recreation.
- Mr. Clapp reported that he, Mr. Scott Moles, and Mr. Sean Reese had received an anonymous complaint about hazmat being stored on the banks of Bogastow Brook off of Fiske Street. Mr. Clapp had prepared an Enforcement Order prescribing its removal, but as of this afternoon, it had been removed. As such, there was no need for an Enforcement Order.
- Mr. Clapp noted on a site inspection on Fiske Street, he noticed signs indicative of Emerald
 Ash Borer in some dead ash trees and recommended the homeowner remove them before it
 spreads. Mr. Nickel forwarded Mr. Clapp a link to report EAB sightings.

- Mr. Clapp reported that Mr. Brian Forestal, from NEMBA, will be present at the next meeting on 8/20/19.
- Mr. Clapp and Ms. Pilch accompanied Mr. Nick Rossi of MassAudubon on his annual Conservation Restriction monitoring visits for Mellen Street and Warren Woods. Encroachment issues were minor and several were addressed with homeowners during the visit.
- Ms. Pilch reported that the Open Space Committee was working on an Agricultural Preservation Restriction with the Sudbury Valley Trustees off of Highland Street. They were looking for the Town to donate \$500,000 to the property to ensure it remains valuable agricultural land. There will be a site walk before the end of the month.
