On each site, he found deficiencies and alterations and at this time, does not recommend the Commission issue Certificates of Compliance. He has not had the opportunity to review the sites on Pout Lane.

- J. Federico, Guerriere & Halnon, indicated that he did not believe that the deficiencies and alterations were significant, and therefore did not address them in the Requests. R. Weissman noted that there is a process for such minor changes written into the Orders of Conditions.
- R. Clapp will coordinate a site visit with the Commission next week to review these sites further.
