## **Holliston Economic Development Committee Meeting Minutes of July 12, 2018**

<u>Present:</u> Chairman Peter Barbieri, Susan Russo, Lisa Zais, and Matt Coletti. Also present was Town Administrator Jeff Ritter. David Thorn was absent.

<u>Call to Order:</u> The Chairman called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. in the Selectmenøs Meeting Room (#105) of Town Hall.

<u>Approval of Minutes:</u> On a motion by Mr. Coletti, seconded by Mrs. Russo, with all in favor, the members approved the minutes of June 7, 2018 as drafted.

## General Business:

- 1. <u>Downtown Updates</u>: Mr. Ritter provided an update on the traffic signal installation project. Work is completed except for the mid-block mast arm removal. Activation is slated for next week. It was noted that America in Bloom judges wil be in Town next week and the community clean-up is scheduled for this weekend. Bobby Blair was present in the audience and was given kudos for the committee¢s efforts. No updates on the status of 9 Green Street were available.
- 2. Business and Community Guide: Draft copy from GDP Publishing was reviewed.
- 3. Nuisance By-Law and Sign & Façade Program Review: Members reviewed the Town of Framingham By-Law, Article V õHealth and Safetyö and discussed the need for a general by-law. Issues of defining subjective terms such as blight, dilapidated, and nuisance followed. Further discussion of pursuit of a sign & façade program followed. Mr. Ritter offered July 30<sup>th</sup> as a potential meeting date with the Board of Selectmen. Notice of the discussion should be provided to the Holliston Business Association and shared on Facebook.
- 4. <u>General Business</u>: Mr. Coletti noted the presence of a Facebook Group called õHolliston Business Happeningsö with 1000 members that could be used for feedback on any number of issues.
