FINANCE COMMITTEE MINUTES EXECUTIVE SESSION JUNE 28, 2011

Richard Johnson explained the time frame the Open Space Committee has to apply for a land grant from the state to purchase the Wheeler Farm. They must apply to the state by July 14, 2011 for the \$500,000 land grant. The Open Space Committee went before the BOS asking for an amount not to exceed \$3000 for a review appraisal, which was approved. Now they need to have the house on the property appraised and this will cost about \$1500. They will need to go back to the BOS for this.

Gordon Johnson, seconded by Mark Schultz, made a MOTION to authorize the Open Space Committee to expend up to \$1500 for a house appraisal and up to \$3000 for a review appraisal for possible acquisition of an open space parcel. Passed 5-0-1 (M. Schultz, abs.)
