Discussion of Andrews School – Demo Application

Abatement is complete.

It will take 2-3 weeks to demolish

Goal is to construct four single family homes

If the septic is a problem, then it may be two duplex

10,000 square foot lots

Frank – could vote to preserve but not fair to neighborhood or builder.

Judy – it meets every criteria for historically significant – It’s unique.

If it had been condemned, then it would not come before Historic Commission.

KS – Why don’t we take one vote to deem the property preferably preserved then take a second vote to not enforce the delay

Close out demolition delay after a discussion with the building. Suspend or revoke the bylaw with much regret.

In a unanimous vote, the commission voted to preferably preserve the Andrews School. In a second unanimous vote, the commission voted with much regret to revoke or suspend the requirements of the bylaw.
