Dental Insurance

Ms. Bousquet informed the Committee that Kevin Walsh from GBS Insurance had heard back from Altus and Delta Dental. Altus had agreed to cover independents to age 26 and white composites on all surfaces at no additional cost. Delta Dental would offer the same coverage but rates would increase 2%.

Mr. Nemet made a motion to accept Altus Dental as the dental insurance for the next three fiscal years (FY16-FY19). Seconded by: Ms. Greendale Vote: Unanimous

Surviving Spouses

Mr. Waugh reviewed the policy that the IAC approved on September 10, 2014, Chapter 32B, Section 9D which requires a 50/50 contribution and the cost of covering the 7 surviving spouses we currently have.

Mr. Waugh informed the Committee that he would request the Board of Selectmen to place an article on the Town Meeting warrant for the adoption of Chapter 32B, Section 9D or file a citizens' petition which requires 10 signatures. Ms. Greendale reminded the group that the warrant closed on March 18, 2015.
