Police Officers on duty for the day were: ANDREW MACGRAY (7-2) and JEFF OTERI (2-9).

Prior to the opening of the polls all four ballot boxes were opened and found to be empty and the counters registered at 0. The tapes from the machines were properly hung on the wall next to the door for public display.

All four voting areas were checked by the inspectors, including each voting station and the station for handicapped persons. The Warden and the Clerk opened and checked each ballot box to be sure they were empty.

After the election workers were sworn in by the Town Clerk, the Warden declared the polls open for voting at 7 AM.

The weather at 6 AM was cold, snow started at 9AM and continued throughout the day and night.

Precinct 2 had a problem with counted ballot in machine, the ballots were getting stuck at the top of the ballot box. This happened 10 times through the day.

At 8 PM the Warden declared the polls closed and the ballot box registers were as follows:

Precinct 1: 306
Precinct 2: 344 (plus 1 hand count)
Precinct 3: 274
Precinct 4: 252
TOTAL 1,177

Following the close of the polls, the Town Clerk swore in the following people as ballot counters: Michelle Hamilton, Megan O'Brien, Carl Damigella, Debbie Kerrigan, Pam Poor, Amanda Lacey, Charlotte Lacey.

The ballots were gone through precinct by precinct, checking for write in ballots for every office. The preliminary results were announced at 8:20 PM.
