PROJECT STATUS

WELL #4 TREATMENT PLANT PROJECT

Mr. Valovcin reported that the department is monitoring the scraper on the ACTIFLOW UNIT at Well #4 Treatment Plant.

He has informed the Project Engineers that they must speed up their work on the punch list. All invoices for work must be paid before May 1, 2014

BROWN WATER – OAK STREET AREA

The Water Department is responding to complaints from residents that allow the department to investigate the problem.

Brown water reported in the Oak Street area of town occurred because the Hopping Brook tank was shut down and the directional change in the water flow resulted in iron and manganese particles in the water.

Mr. Valovcin reported that the department is flushing out home service lines in the Dalton Road area of town.

STAFFING

Two Agreements for Stipends were signed by Mr. Antonioli and Mr. Keating. A sample õOfferö letter was reviewed. The Board discussed the timing to be allowed for taking DEP courses in the offer letter. Mr. Valovcin will confer with Paul LeBeau, Town Administrator, regarding grounds for dismissal.

The Temporary Labor Budget line would provide the money to pay for the two stipends.

BUDGET

In creating the FY15 Budget for the Water Department, Mr. Valovcin has not received any information concerning the ENTERPRISE FUND from the Town Accountant or the Finance Committee.
