May 16, 2019

### Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Errickson at 6:04 pm.

P. Barbieri brought the committee up to speed on the events leading up to and including town meeting. He was able to meet with the CPC ahead of town meeting and get them to commit to funding the project behind Casey's if we didn't get the grant. With that done, the finance committee was able to give favorable recommendation and the funding passed at town meeting.

Some discussion arose on the easement near Casey's. We need to have GLM make a detail plan so that we can prepare an RFP for the work. Possibly have the lighting as an add-on. It was suggested that we off-set the post and rail fence so that you cannot go straight through.

The bids should be back around July. Peter will meet with GLM to get the specs ready for bid. Peter will let us know when he will meet with GLM. We are looking at a possible September start date.

The discussion then turned to the area around Blair Square, mostly about bathrooms. It would appear that unless the selectmen agree to have the bathrooms maintained, then they would become a dead issue. It was suggested that we set up a meeting with the selectmen, hopefully for June 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:30, prior to their meeting. K. Connelly was going to try and wet this up.
