BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES JUNE 19, 2014

The meeting convened at 7:20 p.m. in High School Auditorium. Chairman Kevin Conley, Clerk Jay Leary and Town Administrator Paul Le Beau were present. Vice-Chairman Jay Marsden was absent.

The Board attended a Downtown Visioning forum hosted by Mary Greendale with facilitators Kathy Bartolini and Jamie Errickson. Approximately 75 people attended the forum.

Ms. Bartolini led the group in a discussion of a survey of the current conditions in the downtown area and a survey of what people would like the downtown to be in the future.

Mr. Conley suggested that folks think about how to balance the various concerns that have been expressed about narrowing the roadway, slowing traffic, improving safety for pedestrians and bicyclists, enhancing use of the rail trail, exploring a communal septic arrangement for businesses, creating an environment for people to gather and enhancing business activity.

Mr. Errickson led a map exercise, encouraging people to identify physical changes to the downtown that they would like to see.

The completed surveys and maps were collected for analysis.

At 9:20 p.m. Mr. Leary moved, Mr. Conley seconded and it was voted two in favor with Mr. Marsden absent to adjourn the meeting.
