BOARD OF SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES HOLLISTON TOWN HALL DECEMBER 26, 2018

Present: Jay Marsden, Chairman; Mark Ahronian, Vice Chairman; John Cronin, Clerk

Also present: Jeff Ritter, Town Administrator

- J. Marsden called the meeting to order at 8:17a.m.
- 1.) Warrant: J. Cronin read the Warrant and made a motion to approve the weekly vendor (expense) and payroll Warrant (19-26) in the amount of \$292,996.89. Second, M. Ahronian. Voted 3-0
- **2.) Public Comment:** M. Ahronian said the Mudville stop sign have been ordered but can't do any stencile painting on the road until the weather breaks.
- J. Cronin said he would not be able to attend the Board meeting scheduled for Wednesday, January 2, 2019.
- **3.)** Rocky: J. Marsden provided a summary of his conversation with Town Counsel. Town Counsel recommended the Board make a motion to set-aside the Clerk of the Court's decision to relocate Rocky to another community until Holliston can ge5t before the appropriate judge.
- J. Cronin noted the appeal could take several months and the destroy order still stands. There is a public safety issues and a responsibility to report Rocky to another community if in fact Rocky has been removed.
- M. Ahronian said it would be appropriate for the Board to issue a restrained and muzzle order until the matter can be resolved.

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- J. Marsden made a motion to authorize Town Counsel to take any reasonable action to uphold the Board's original decision. Second, M. Ahronian. Voted 3-0
- J. Marsden made a motion to request from the Court that Rocky be muzzled and restrained while in Holliston or until the matter has been re4solved. Second, M. Ahronian. Voted 3-0
- J. Marsden made a motion that Rocky be muzzled and restrained if Rocky is moved to another community. Second, M. Ahronian. Voted 3-0
- **4.)** Class II License: M. Ahronian made a motion to approve, grant and sign a Class II License for the Holliston Auto Village. Second, J. Cronin. Voted 3-0

Adjourn: M. Ahronian made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:53a.m. Second, J. Cronin. Voted 3-0
