Barn: Still waiting on Mark Dellicker

Apiary: Curtis Armitage works with Veterans affairs may have some vets that would be interested in having some hives at the apiary. We need to get down there to do some clean-up of trees that fell in storms and over growth for safety. Also add some boards to the fence for protection from animals.

We really need to start finding some volunteers to help around the farm with clean ups, signage, and all other projects.

We may need to rework the community plots agreement, which would have the renters more responsible for clean up around the plots.

We need to check in again with Conservation Commission about the CR and where we stand with it.
