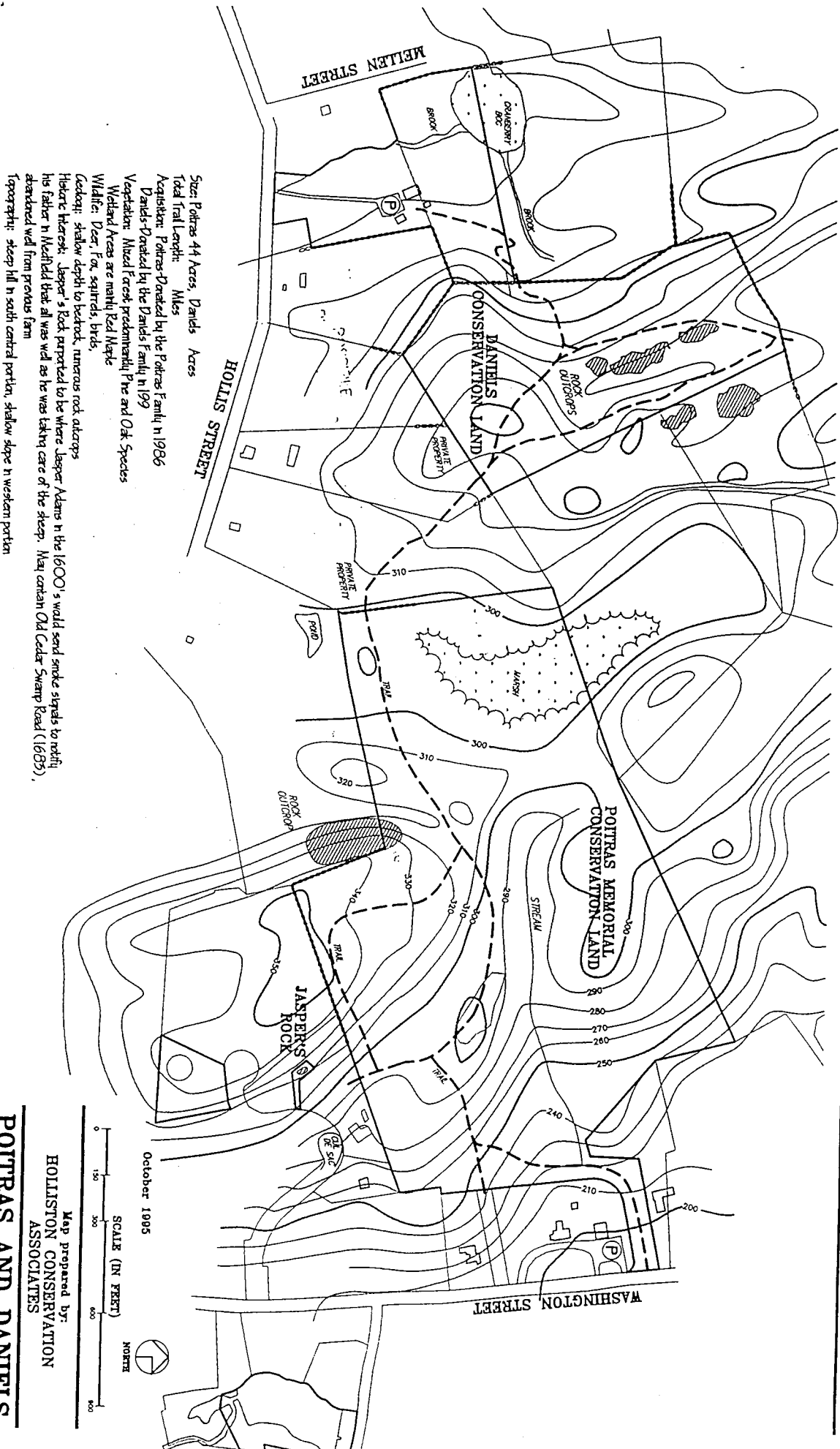




Size: Pottrass 44 Acres, Daniels Acres

Total Trail Length: Miles

Acquisition: Pottrass Donated by the Pottrass Family in 1986

Daniels Donated by the Daniels Family in 1999

Vegetation: Mixed Forest, predominantly Pine and Oak Species

Wildlife: Deer, Fox, squirrels, birds,

Geology: shallow depth to bedrock, numerous rock outcrops

Historic Interest: Jasper's Rock purported to be where Jasper Adams in the 1600's would send snake spirits to notify his father in Medford that all was well as he was taking care of the sheep. Map contains Old Cedar Swamp Road (1685), abandoned well from previous farm

Topography: steep hill in south central portion, shallow slope in western portion
