- Mr. Bajdek read the legal advertisement into the record.
- Mr. Scott Goddard, representative for the applicant, presented the project to the Commission.
 The site is an existing sports club and they propose to repurpose it into single family houses.
 The project will require an ANR from the Planning Board. This project will result in a net reduction in impervious surface due to elimination of parking areas and the tennis courts.
- Mr. Bajdek noted several wells onsite, including one within the 50' No Disturbance Zone, and inquired as to their purpose. Mr. Chris Nation, applicant, noted that they were unsure of availability of town water, so the wells would be for water use in the house. Mr. Bajdek noted that with the proximity to the wetlands, the Commission may require a hydrologic study to determine possible wetland impacts. Ms. Weissman requested the applicant assess the possibility of relocating the well outside the 50' No Disturbance Zone.
- Dr. Rutberg inquired if the patio as proposed within the 50' No Disturbance Zone was pervious or impervious. Mr. Goddard noted it could be either, depending on the Commission's requirements.
- Mr. Lively requested wetland bounds along the 50' No Disturbance Zone. Mr. Goddard agreed.
- The Commission expressed that work within the 50' No Disturbance Zone should be avoided
 to the maximum extent possible. Ms. Weissman noted a caveat that there is some leeway as
 the area is previously disturbed, and ultimately the project is an improvement over existing
 conditions.

Per DEP's comments, the infiltration part of the detention basin has been relocated outside the 50' No Disturbance Buffer Zone, which resulted in an expanded basin and therefore a reduced amount of impervious surfaces onsite. The applicant has also revised the landscaping to native plantings and have added wetland markers. As of yet, ther has not been a response on the stormwater peer review requiring any revisions.
- Mr. Lively inquired if the basin had an overflow pipe. Mr. Merrikin confirmed there was.
