



## **Relief Driver**

The Town of Holliston is seeking applicants for a part time van driver to drive seniors and disabled adults to appointments, grocery shopping, senior center programs, and local errands. May also deliver meals to homebound seniors. Driver will operate a 10 passenger mini bus.

Experience with seniors and/or the disabled adult population is preferred. Ability to be flexible, kind and compassionate is essential.

The successful candidate will have a state driver's license with a good driving record. A knowledge of Holliston and surrounding towns is desirable.

Drivers must be willing to participate in all required trainings, including first aid, CPR and wheelchair life/securement. Drivers must be able to successfully complete a pre-employment physical, drug test, CORI check and Driving Record Check.

Pursuant to the Town's Consolidated Personnel By-laws, this position is classified as Grade 100 Step 1 which is \$17.47 per hour. This is a part time, non -benefit eligible position with variable hours up to 19 hours per week.
