Risks to the proposed budget:

1 Professional Services budget remains the same for fourth year. Support Contracts are increasing this year but this years increase will be covered by a MIIA Grant the Town received this year (see opportunity #3 below)

FY21 BUDGET REQUEST

- 2 China/US continue to discuss technology tariff's, current computer footprint price has increased \$30 this year
- 3 Town/School wide anti virus contract has been renewed for 1 year at current price will continue to work with the schools to leverage their purchasing power again next year but might effect Professional Service budget in 2022.
- 4 Town obtained grant for Cyber Security Training Program. This is a user based program. Grant is for 1 year. Any new hires after December 2020 if Grant is not extended cannot be trained through the program as current Technology Budget does not allow for purchasing the program (See Opportunity #4)
- 5 By September 2020 95 of the 136 Computers will have been upgraded to Windows 10. Remaining 43 will be vulnerable with Windows 7 for up to 2 years Looking to postpone a Server install in 2021 and instead increase number of computers next year to get most replaced in 4 years.

Opportunities for further budgetary savings:

- 1 Second Year of new Computer Equipment is underway. So far, 60 new Windows 10 computers and 2 servers have been replaced/ordered. 30 Police Station Desktop Computers scheduled July 2020
- 2 Continue to work with the Schools to leverage buying power
- 3 Worked with MIIA to obtain Grant to pay for 10 years worth of Building/Server Room monitoring to save \$225 a year on Professional Services to offset other increases in Support Contracts
- 4 Town/School is looking to leverage free Cyber Security Training and Videos from MIIA for all other staff/new staff after December 2020 not included in State Training Program
