The auxiliary unit members will miss these officers as they have made such a contribution to the unit. The Auxiliary Unit currently had two trainees graduate from the MPTC reserve academy and will begin their field training.

Due to Governor's COVID-19 Order #13 (issued March 23, 2020), which prohibited gatherings of more than ten (10) people, the Chief of Police, for the safety of the community, canceled all permits for special events within the town.

PERSONNEL

Two Auxiliary Officers recently graduated from the Massachusetts Reserve Intermittent Academy. One attended the South Suburban Police Institute in Foxboro, MA, and the Northeast Regional Police Institute in Chelmsford, MA. Both academies were 372.5-hour courses that encompass mandatory training to keep officers vigilant safe while out on patrol. They will both begin their auxiliary training for patrol shifts, pedestrian crossing, and crowd control for the foreseeable special events. The unit is currently seeking more applicants to fill the void of the two officers.

PATROL LOG SUMMARY

During the fiscal year 2021, the Holliston Auxiliary Police patrolled 2206.2 miles on weekend patrols. They had logged 523 town-owned property site checks and 1,158 commercial and other building checks. During these site checks, a total of three (3) doors and windows were found unsecured. Auxiliary Officers on patrol responded to two (2) motor vehicle crashes, four (4) medical calls, one (1) alarm, twenty (20) motor vehicle assists, and sixty (60) miscellaneous incidents (i.e., wire down). The unit also patrolled the rail trail and town parks on several other means such as foot, bicycle, and UTV.
