Pleasure Point Park & Beach

Pleasure Point Beach is reserved for Holliston residents. The lakefront area includes a swimming area with a sandy beach, playground, picnic table, and portable restrooms during the summer season. Boat ramp is at the far end of the parking lot (no motorized boats). There are approximately 20 parking spaces. In-season beach sticker or day pass required. Day pass is available for purchase at the gate for \$15 (resident only) GPS address: 100 Pleasure Point Road, Holliston MA

Stoddard Park & Beach

The lakefront area of Stoddard Park boasts a swimming area with a sandy beach, playground, covered pavilion, picnic tables, and two volleyball courts. During operating hours, the beach is staffed with lifeguards and restrooms are open. There are approximately 70 parking spaces. Inseason beach sticker or day pass required. Day pass is available for purchase at the gate: \$15 resident/\$20 non-resident.

Lake Winthrop Beach Rules

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH RULES LISTED BELOW WILL RESULT IN LOSS OF WATERFRONT AND PARK PRIVILEGES.

-When Camp Patoma is in session please park in the designated areas. The parking lot is very busy from 3:45pm-4:15pm M-F during camp pick up. If arriving or leaving during this time, please be patient and cooperate with staff directions to keep everyone safe.

- 1. Beach sticker or day pass required. Beach sticker must be affixed on lower corner of driver's front windshield.
- 2. Swim at own risk when no lifeguard on duty.
- 3. Children under age 12 must be supervised by an adult.
- 4. No grills or open flames.
- 5. No alcohol allowed.
- 6. No glass containers.
- 7. No dogs or pets.
- 8. Do not feed the geese or ducks.
- 9. No nude bathing.
- 10. No boats, kayaks or paddleboards allowed in the swimming area.
- 11. No smoking on park or beach grounds.
- 12. Do not climb on the Lifeguard Stands.
- 13. No diapers. Only leak resistant swim pants are permitted.
- 14. No fishing permitted on the beachfront.
- 15. Swimmers must remain inside the designated swimming area.
- 16. No floatation devices are permitted except Coast Guard approved life jackets.

Please ask a lifeguard to check if your lifejacket is Coast Guard approved.

- 17. Non-swimmers wearing approved lifejackets in the deep end MUST be accompanied by a parent or guardian within arm's reach at all times.
- 18. Dock use is limited to: a) swimmers who demonstrate ability by swimming independently to the dock and b) non-swimmers who are wearing approved life jackets and are accompanied by a parent/guardian within arm's reach at all times.
- 19. No dives, flips, or twists are permitted from the dock.
- 20. Do not swim underneath or directly in front of the dock.
- 21. No snorkels, fins, or large beach balls (larger than a volleyball).
