1750 Update

Directors Report

Ms. Hedrick brought some preliminary numbers for the summer waterfront. It seems that we made a little bit of money this summer, about \$4,317.04. This money will go back into the Waterfront for improvements.

Summer went well we have some feedback from our surveys. There was one Pre-K program where we did not get great feedback and we will not be running that program again. Ms. Hedrick will have a complete report at the November meeting.

Fields

Mr. Nemet reported that the youth football has started using the Adams field for practices at night with the lights on Tuesdays & Thursdays. Mr. Chipman and Mr. Nemet have been turning the lights on and off for the groups. Mr. Healy wanted to know if they could put a timer so that they would not have to go down there each night. Mr. Chipman said there is a way to do it with an App on your phone but did not think this was an option since there are other groups that use the lights and have them turn off at different times each night.

One Hundred Linden Street, the former location of the Parks & Recreation Offices has been completely demolished and there is now grass in its place.
