B. Determinations

Pursuant to the authority of M.G.L. c. 131, § 40 and Article XXXI of the Bylaws of the Town of Holliston, the Conservation Commission considered your Request for Determination of Applicability, with its supporting documentation, and made the following Determinations.

Project Description (if applicable):

The applicant proposes the construction of a 7,200 sqft building with a 120'x60' paved pad off the front and back of the building. The building would be served by a newly proposed septic system underneath the parking pad. Site grading is proposed to extend the earthen berm to the west of the site for noise control, and to extend the perimeter berm up to elevation 160.

The 7.1 acre parcel is currenty developed and used for contractor operations including material processing. Wetlands associated with Bogastow Brook (a perennial stream) are located to the west of the site, with a 100-year floodplain along the westerly property line up to elevation 157.

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the city or town in which such land is located, are hereby notified of their right to request the appropriate Department of Environmental Protection Regional Office (see

http://www.mass.gov/dep/about/region.findyour.htm) to issue a Superseding Determination of Applicability. The request must be made by certified mail or hand delivery to the Department, with the appropriate filing fee and Fee Transmittal Form (see Request for Departmental Action Fee Transmittal Form) as provided in 310 CMR 10.03(7) within ten business days from the date of issuance of this Determination. A copy of the request shall at the same time be sent by certified mail or hand delivery to the Conservation Commission and to the applicant if he/she is not the appellant. The request shall state clearly and concisely the objections to the Determination which is being appealed.

To the extent that the Determination is based on the Holliston Wetlands Administration Bylaw and not on the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act or regulations, the Department of Environmental Protection has no appellate jurisdiction.

Determinations issued under the Holliston Wetlands Administrative Bylaw, Article XXXI of the Bylaws of the Town of Holliston, may be appealed to the MA Superior Court, or in certain limited circumstances the the MA Land Court, under the provisions of M.G.L. Ch. 249, s.4, within 60 days of the date of issuance. Appeals taken to the MA Department of Environmental Protection under the MA Wetlands Protection Act only have no impact or effect on Determinations issued pursuant to the Holliston Wetlands Administration Bylaw, Article XXXI.
