



Weekly COVID-19 Report

When the DPH published the updated town by town information this evening, our community risk designation remained at the **RED** level, based on new cases in the 14 day period ending January 8. According to their weekly reports, our numbers increased from 130.1 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on January 6 to 217.5 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on January 13. Our percent positivity increased from 12.13% last week to 18% this week.

Green: less than 10 cases per 100,000 population AND greater than 10 total cases

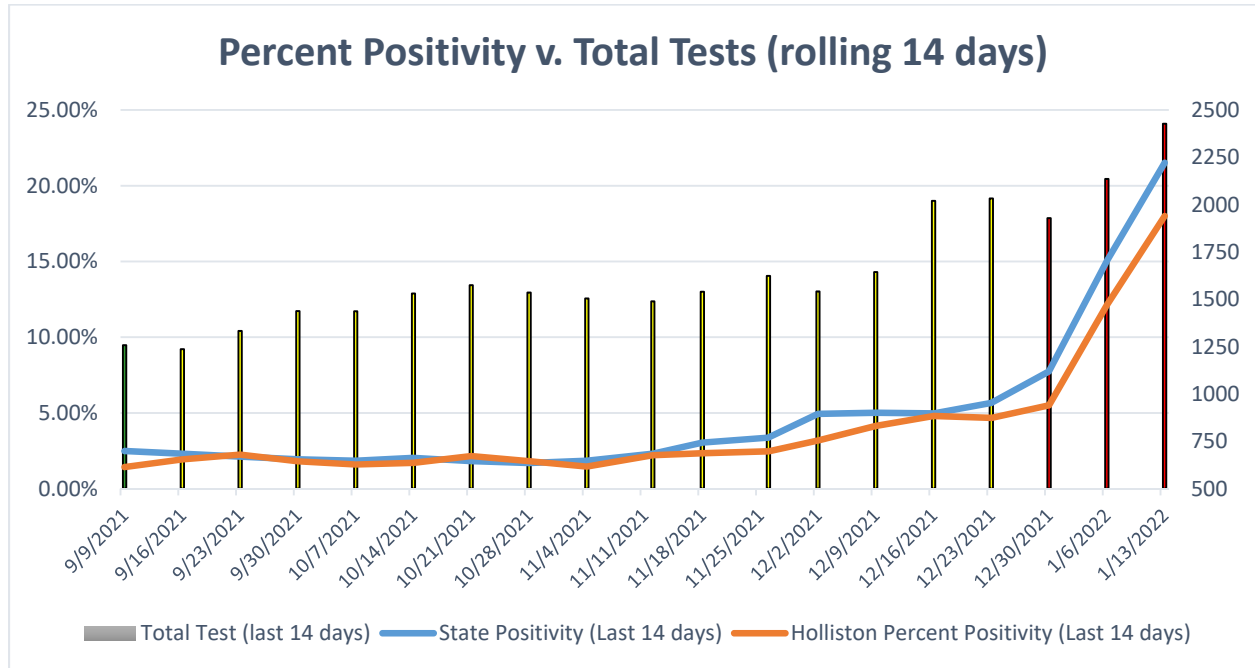
Yellow: greater than or equal to 10 cases per 100,000 population OR greater than or equal to 5% positivity rate

We currently have eighty-four active cases; including three clusters in single family homes, three individual cased in multi-family dwellings, and one cluster in a multi-family dwelling.

According to vaccination data by community released by the state, 99.4% of the population is partially vaccinated, and 90% of the population is fully vaccinated as of January 11. As of the report 113% of the 65-74 age group, and 115% of the 75+ age group had received at least 1 shot. As of this report, data also showed 87% of the 5-11 year old, 115% of the 12-15 year olds, and 126% of the 16-19 year olds having already received at least one shot.



In the last week, the number of cases increased the most in the 10-19 (15%), 0-9 (14%), 40-49 (11%), 60-69 (9%), 20-29, 30-39 and 50-59 (8%), and 80-89 (6%) ages.
