

Weekly COVID-19 Report

When the DPH published the updated town by town information this evening, our community risk designation remained at the RED level, based on new cases in the 14 day period ending May 7. According to their weekly reports, our numbers raised from 33.3 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on May 5 to 34.3 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on May 12. Our percent positivity lowered from 7.26% last week to 7.08% this week.

Gray: less than or equal to 10 total cases



We currently have thirty four active cases; including twenty four individual cases in single family homes, three clusters in single family homes, two individual cases in multi-family dwellings, and one individual case in a congregate care setting.

According to vaccination data by community released by the state, 102% of the population is partially vaccinated, and 93% of the population is fully vaccinated as of May 10. As of the report 116% of the 65-74 age group, and 115% of the 75+ age group had received at least 1 shot. As of this report, data also showed 96% of the 5-11 year old, 119% of the 12-15 year olds, and 127% of the 16-19 year olds having already received at least one shot.

In the last week, the number of cases increased the most in the 60-69 (4%), 0-9 and 80-89 (3%), and 10-19, 30-39, 40-49, and 50-59 (2%) ages.
