

Weekly COVID-19 Report

When the DPH published the updated town by town information this evening, our community risk designation remained at the **GREY** level, based on new cases in the 14 day period ending July 3. According to their weekly reports, our numbers lowered from 0.5 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on July 1 to 0 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on July 8. Our percent positivity decreased from 0.28% last week to 0% this week.



We currently have one active case at a single family home.

According to vaccination data by community released by the state, 82% of the population is partially vaccinated, and 76% of the population is fully vaccinated as of July 6. As of the report 102% of the 65-74 age group, and 104% of the 75+ age group had received at least 1 shot. As of this report, data also showed 94% of the 12-15 year olds and 112% of the 16-19 year olds having already received at least one shot.







On Tuesday, July 6, the Emergency Management Director provided the following *CARES Act* spending breakdown to the Select Board. The chart represents municipal spending, and does not reflect expenses charged to the ESSER or *CARES Act* funds received by the schools. The Planning and Development Expenses do reflect technology purchased by the schools, for which the Select Board had committed municipal *CARES* funding prior to the July 2020 Annual Town Meeting. The amounts indicated are prior to any potential reimbursement for eligible expenses.
