

## **Weekly COVID-19 Report**

When the DPH published the updated town by town information this evening, our community risk designation remained at the YELLOW level, based on new cases in the 14 day period ending November 27. According to their weekly reports, our numbers raised from 19.8 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on November 26 to 24.5 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on December 2. Our percent positivity raised from 2.46% last week to 3.18% this week.

Gray: less than or equal to 10 total cases



We currently have twenty-seven individual cases in single family homes, five clusters in single family homes, and an individual case in a multi-family dwelling.


According to vaccination data by community released by the state, 98% of the population is partially vaccinated, and 83% of the population is fully vaccinated as of November 30. As of the report 119% of the 65-74 age group, and 118% of the 75+ age group had received at least 1 shot. As of this report, data also showed 67% of the 5-11 year old, 114% of the 12-15 year olds, and 123% of the 16-19 year olds having already received at least one shot.

In the last week, the number of cases increased the most in the 10-19 and 40-49 (5%), 30-39 and 50-59 (3%), and 0-9 and 20-29 (2%) ages.





On Monday, November 29, the Emergency Management Director provided the following *CARES Act* spending breakdown to the Select Board. The chart represents municipal spending, and does not reflect expenses charged to the ESSER or *CARES Act* funds received by the schools. The Planning and Development Expenses do reflect technology purchased by the schools, for which the Select Board had committed municipal *CARES* funding prior to the July 2020 Annual Town Meeting. The amounts indicated are prior to any potential reimbursement for eligible expenses.
