

Weekly COVID-19 Report

When the DPH published the updated town by town information this evening, our community risk designation remained at the RED level, based on new cases in the 14 day period ending January 29. According to their weekly reports, our numbers lowered from 161.3 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on January 27 to 101.5 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on February 3. Our percent positivity lowered from 15.9% last week to 12.34% this week.

Gray: less than or equal to 10 total cases



We currently have sixty-three active cases; including eight clusters in single family homes, two clusters in multi-family dwellings, and two individual cases in multi-family dwellings.

According to vaccination data by community released by the state, 101% of the population is partially vaccinated, and 91% of the population is fully vaccinated as of February 1. As of the report 113% of the 65-74 age group, and 116% of the 75+ age group had received at least 1 shot. As of this report, data also showed 91% of the 5-11 year old, 117% of the 12-15 year olds, and 126% of the 16-19 year olds having already received at least one shot.

In the last week, the number of cases increased the most in the 40-49 (4%), 0-9, and 50-59 (3%), and 10-19 and 60-69 (2%) ages.
