

Weekly COVID-19 Report

When the DPH published the updated town by town information this evening, our community risk designation changed to the **GREEN** level, based on new cases in the 14 day period ending September 4. According to their weekly reports, our numbers lowered from 13 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on September 2 to 7.8 Average Daily Incident Rate per 100,000 on September 9. Our percent positivity lowered from 2.15% last week to 1.43% this week.



*last 14 days refers to the two-week reporting period ending the Saturday prior to the DPH's weekly report


We currently have six individual cases at single family homes.

According to vaccination data by community released by the state, 85% of the population is partially vaccinated, and 79% of the population is fully vaccinated as of September 7. As of the report 104% of the 65-74 age group, and 105% of the 75+ age group had received at least 1 shot. As of this report, data also showed 106% of the 12-15 year olds and 119% of the 16-19 year olds having already received at least one shot.





In the last week, the number of cases increased the most in the 0-9 (2%) and 30-39 and 60-69 (1%) age ranges.





On Monday, September 6, the Emergency Management Director provided the following *CARES Act* spending breakdown to the Select Board. The chart represents municipal spending, and does not reflect expenses charged to the ESSER or *CARES Act* funds received by the schools. The Planning and Development Expenses do reflect technology purchased by the schools, for which the Select Board had committed municipal *CARES* funding prior to the July 2020 Annual Town Meeting. The amounts indicated are prior to any potential reimbursement for eligible expenses.
