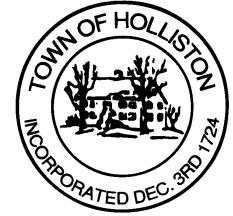

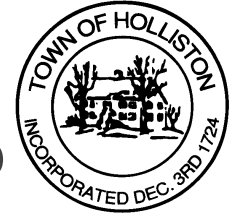

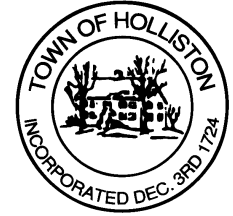
# What was the purpose of the survey?

---

The first survey was meant to determine WHAT matters to residents about the town.

- What do people like about the town? What concerns do residents have?
- How different ideas rank to the people of the town.
- With this information, a VISION statement can be created
- Existing studies, by-laws, and information can be mined for policy
- Gaps in information and law can be found

The second survey will help determine HOW residents want to reach the goals set forth by the first survey.



# Survey recap

---

Survey opened on 11/8/21 and closed on 1/21/22.

- Survey was online and accessible via QR code or through the town's website.
- 3 responses were on paper at the senior center and entered by hand.

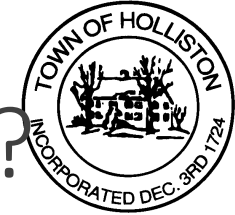
400 Total responses

380 unique emails: 10 emails had 2 responses

Not everyone ranked 1-11

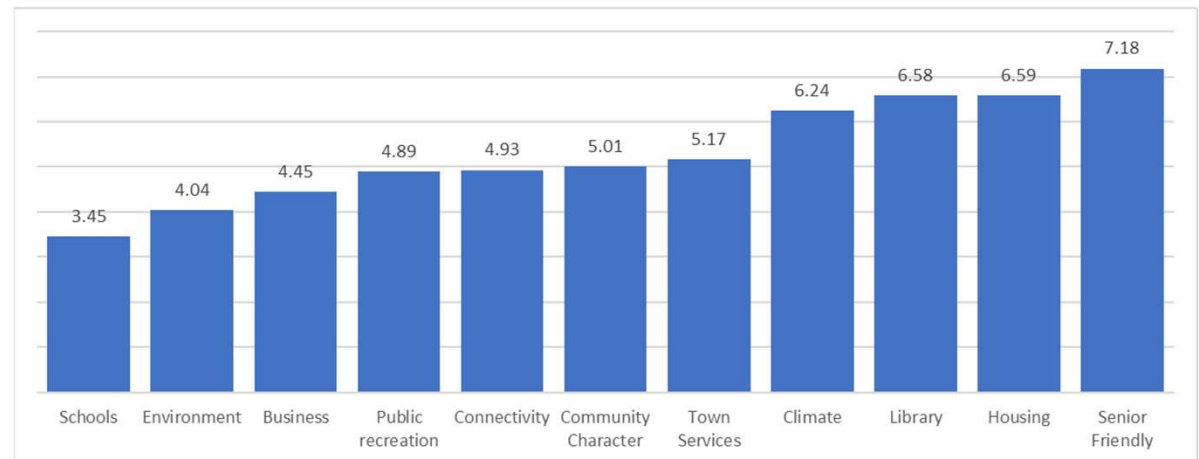
- 618 items listed as #1. 15 respondents had no #1, 78 surveys had multiple #1 items

Not all questions were answered by all respondents

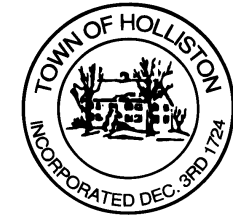

Schools, environment (water, open space, and agriculture) and business are top responses

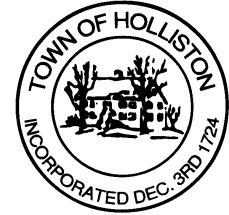

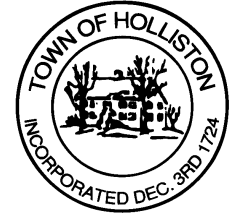

Word clouds were used to evaluate the long answers of respondents

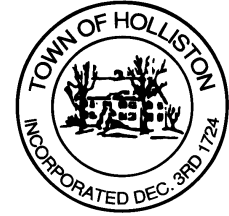
This would help reduce a reader's bias to see what they wanted/expected in the text.

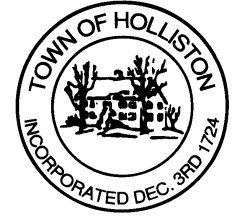

# Conclusions/Recommendations

---

Survey reached 400 people and gives a statistically reasonable result

This survey told us WHAT matters to residents, but not HOW to reach those goals.

From these responses, a “vision” for Holliston could be created

There should be research on the topics outlined by residents and priorities brought forward

For survey #2,

- we would need at least 400 responses
- Should aim for 1000. After that, we would be “paying” for less significant findings.
- Need to find ways to reach under 19 and 80+
- In addition to understanding what is important, second survey should ask what changes people would want to meet goals (if any).
