We are pleased to announce that the program has been extended until March 31, 2022 as our efforts to increase awareness and expand the installation of solar and clean energy technologies are paying off.

The program began in late June 2021 and is open to residents and small businesses in Holliston, Ashland, Natick and Framingham. Vendors were selected through a competitively selected procurement process to partner with us in providing cost effective solar and heat pump technology options to residents and small businesses.

Through the first six months of the program, contracts for over sixty air source and ground source (geothermal) heat pumps have been signed and new incentives have been proposed for the Mass Save program. In addition, more than fifty-five solar contracts have been executed equating to more than 500kw of electricity generated in the MetroWest area. It was nice seeing the first solar installation in the program take place in Holliston!
