




Front Street Proposed One Way Conversion and Pedestrian Access Zone





PROPOSED pedestrian median refuge island installation along Washington Street on either approach to the intersection with Linden Street. The median island provides the following benefits:

- reduced exposure of people crossing to traffic by reducing the length of the crosswalk
- reduced number of simultaneous vehicular threats to people crossing
- increased driver awareness of the marked crosswalk
- increased potential of speed limit adherence

The existing and proposed road cross sections in the vicinity of the proposed medians are shown on the next sheet.
