Data Report: 7 New referrals; 52 clients, 3 court diversion clients.

Court diversion clients created lawn signs for suicide awareness with positive mental wellness messages as well as resources for help and prevention.

3. Rent and Mortgage Relief - Vote to support another round of funding
 - So far there have been two rounds of rent and mortgage relief that supported 27 families in total.
 - There is still CARES money available at the town level. This vote is to bring a request forward to the Selectboard, requesting additional funding to support rent and mortgage relief. This funding has been especially beneficial for families who don't meet the income requirements for poverty guidelines.
