The purpose of this email, should we consider a noise review of the property once all of these bays are rented? Maybe a baseline review at nearest receptor. (Rail Trail) It was my understanding that they would be more Contractor Type Storage over actual cutting of countertops or other manufacturing.

Should we consider a Noise Limit as the nearest receptor is the Rail Trail.

In order to reduce Noise on Saturday, Sunday and Holidays, consider no cutting of granite on those days. Question would a simple core hole for a sink be allowed?
